Chapters

- Host a virtual event with a panel of Hispanic or Latin leaders from a community, local business, and government agencies.
- Host an in-person (or virtual) Latin-themed dance party at your next chapter event with these <u>songs</u>.
- Include articles (with the appropriate citations/references) about Hispanic/Latino history, culture, food, music, and traditions in the next issue of your newsletter.
