

I have had the pleasure of serving on the Nutrition Foodservice Education Foundation Board also known as the Board of Trustees since 2016. I was excited to be asked to serve as the Chair by Ken Hansen in 2020 for the 2021 year. I thought I would share where the money we raise for the NFEF goes.

The Foundation awarded 91 grants to current and aspiring CDM, CFPPs in FY21, totaling \$25,420. This included an additional 31 grants, an increase of 67%, to ANFP members impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 for the Members' Dues and Certification Fees grant program.

Other NFEF grants offered to aspiring CDM, CFPPs to help achieve their goals and becoming certified, include the CDM Credentialing Exam and Prep grants. Educational opportunities for current and certified members include the ANFP Annual Conference & Expo and Regional Meeting grants. A student grant program is also offered to students who are currently (or about to become) enrolled into a Dietary Manger Training program.

In FY21, award recipients represent 34 different states across the nation.

The Foundation continues to develop new strategies that promote awareness and continue to offer grant opportunities to current and future CDM, CFPPs through the generous donations received, including our Corporate Sponsorship from Sysco Corporation, Direct Supply, Hormel Health Labs, and Performance Foodservice.
